As we mentioned in our last update, we were blessed with a grant from a private Jewish foundation that paid for all our present faculty training in Minfulness. After completing the training, teachers were given a stipend.

This year, the grant afforded the school the opportunity for students to participate in this training. Nothing completely changes overnight, but the school has a more peaceful environment. Alhamdu-lillah.

We are able to provide gas cards to our parents monthly for bringing their children to school and picking them up. Depending on the month, parents receive up to \$200 each month.

The donations we receive through the 100@50 help to provide additional food purchases during our meal program. Presently, are required to contract with a company that has terrible food. Many students will not eat, and we need our children nourished for learning to occur. Daily, we supplement the meal program with nutritious items.
